

“Mobile clinics in Rakhine State carried out over 300,000 patient consultations in 2018”

Ministry of Health and Sports has been providing equal health care services for all communities in Rakhine State. The mobile health teams of Ministry of Health and Sports have been regularly visiting villages of Rakhine State to give health care free of charge and to promote health knowledge through health education and communication activities. Mobile health teams set up mobile clinics in hard to access areas of Rakhine State with the mission to reach remote and insecure areas to provide needed care to populations deprived of essential health services. From January to December 2018, the mobile health teams of Ministry of Health and Sports provided health care for 310,236 patients in Sittwe, Butheedaung, Maungdaw and Yathedaung Townships as shown in the table.
