





COVID-19 confirmed cases by date of laboratory confirmation (as of 20-5-2020,11:00 PM) n=199













Cumulative Quarantine Persons= 215,316 Positive Cases= 25 - - - - Tested Percentage= 2.8%

Summary of new confirmed cases detection after first two cases (as of 20.5.2020)



- Confirmed cases were detected as peak in the 4th week after first confirmed cases due to religious event cluster .
- Confirmed cases were decreased but still raised than the first 3 weeks due to religious event cluster and workplace cluster.
- There were an increased in numbers of cases in week 7th after the first two cases due to household cluster linked with religious cluster.
- Confirmed cases were detected again in week 8 after the first two cases because of returnees .
